HouseProud Atlanta provides free repairs to senior, disabled, and veteran neighbors. From plumbing to roofing and wheelchair-ramp installations, HouseProud Atlanta's key goal is to keep homeowners in their existing homes.

With a multifaceted history, HouseProud Atlanta was officially established as an independent nonprofit in 2012.

In the past year (May 2017 – May 2018) alone, HouseProud Atlanta served 102 senior, veteran and disabled Atlantans to help improve their quality of life.

As seniors age and their homes deteriorate, the cost of repairs and general maintenance can add up. According to the Consumer Expenditure Survey, housing is the greatest expense in dollar amount and as a share of total expenditures for those age 55 and older.

With 76 percent of seniors choose between paying for food or paying for utilities or medicine,* home repair is often the last thing on their minds. Thanks to HouseProud Atlanta, they don't have to choose between making critical home repairs and basic necessities such as food and medicine.

With increased development, many seniors face higher property taxes. The cost of living in homes they've lived in for decades has suddenly become a burden and sparks feelings of fear and uncertainty. Through compassionate and high-quality service, HouseProud Atlanta brings a sense of peace, pride, and community to the golden years.

We preserve homes and community diversity

The value of HouseProud home repairs goes beyond a fresh coat of paint. It all reflects a deep love for Atlanta's rich history and culture. As the city grows, it's important to reinvest in those who helped shaped these communities.

For many longtime Atlantans, their neighborhoods are changing. As their communities evolve, HouseProud aims to bridge the connection between the 'old' and 'new,' ensuring no one gets pushed out or left behind.
